### Have you seen the American Robin?



#### where and when?

- large songbird with gray-brown back and orangey chest and belly
- has a yellow bill and a white ring around the eye
- often found on the ground looking for earthworms and insects

## How about the Northern Cardinal?



#### where and when?

- bird with long, red tail and a crest on its head with a red cone-shaped bill
- often found on shrubs near the ground
- females are pale brown with some red streaks

## Can you find the Blue Jay?



#### where and when?

- large bird with blue on its back and black and white patterns
- has a white belly and a crest on its head and a black "necklace" stripe
  often very noisy

## How about the American Goldfinch?



#### where and when?

- small yellow bird with an orange cone-shaped bill and orange legs
- has black forehead and crown with black wings and tail
- only males are bright in the summer and are more dull like the female in winter

## Can you spot the Mourning Dove?



where and when?

- has a small head for its body and perches on wires with its pink feet
- gray all over with green and pale pink in the face and chest
- often has a dark black spont on the head and wings
