Have you seen the Northern Flicker?



where and when?

- large, brown woodpecker with black circles all over its body
- may have bright red or bright yellow along the shafts of its wings
- has a solid black crescent in the center of its chest

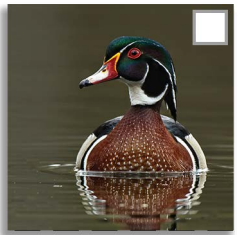
How about the Tree Swallow?



where and when?

- shiny, blue bird with a white throat, chest, and belly
- have long, grayish wings for zipping and twisting through the air
- often flying low over water, catching insects in the air in its small beak

Can you find the Wood Duck?



where and when?

- duck with a large crest on its head, a dark chest, and a white belly patch
- males have a black, shiny rainbow face with red eyes and bill
- females have a gray-brown face with a white tear-drop ring round the eye

How about the Great Blue Heron?



where and when?

- tall, lanky gray-blue bird with long legs, neck, and bill
- white face on a long head, with a deep navy eyebrow stripe and thin crest
- moves slowly along the water, snapping suddenly to catch fish in its bill

Can you spot the Yellow Warbler?



where and when?

- small yellow bird that is streaked brown through its breast and wings
- has bold, black eyes, seen easily against their solid yellow face
- their bills are gray and short
